SCHEDULE

Set forth below are the relevant parts of the definitions of "United States" and "US person" contained in Regulation S promulgated under the US Securities Act of 1933.

"United States" or "US" means the United States of America, its territories and possessions, any State of the United States, and the District of Columbia.

"US person" means any natural person resident in the United States.

The applicant hereby declares, represents and warrants that:

- (a) he will subscribe to the Fund for his own account as principal, for investment purposes only, and not with a view to or for the re-sale, distribution or fractionalisation thereof, in whole or in part; and no other person has or will have a direct or indirect beneficial interest in such shares in the Fund;
- (b) he understands that the offering and sale of shares in the Fund is intended to be exempt from registration under the US Securities Act and any applicable State securities laws and that the Fund will not be registered under the US Investment Company Act in reliance upon exemptions for non-public offerings, and understand that the shares may not be offered, sold, transferred or pledged except pursuant to an effective registration statement under the US Securities Act (the Fund having no intention of effecting a registration under such Act) or pursuant to an available exemption therefrom and any applicable State securities laws;
- (c) he has such knowledge and experience in financial and business matters as to be capable of evaluating the merits of, and he is able to bear the economic risk of, investment in the Fund, including a complete loss of his investment therein;
- (d) he has been given the opportunity to ask questions of, and receive answers from, the Fund with respect to the business to be conducted by the Fund, the financial condition and capital of the Fund, the terms and conditions of the offering and other matters pertaining to investment in the Fund and has been given the opportunity to obtain such additional information necessary to verify the accuracy of the information contained in the Prospectus and Key Investor Information Document in order for him to evaluate the merits and risks of investment in the Fund to the extent that the Fund possesses such information or can acquire it without unreasonable effort or expense;
- (e) he has determined that the Funds are a suitable investment for him at this time;
- (f) with regard to the tax, legal, currency and other economic considerations related to this investment, he has only relied on the advice of, or has only consulted with, his own professional advisers;
- (g) this application is, and upon acceptance by Smith & Williamson, will be, a legal, valid and binding obligation, enforceable against the Applicant in accordance with its terms;
- (h) he has read carefully and is purchasing the shares in the Fund relying solely on the information contained in the Prospectus and Key Investor Information Document in determining to make his investment, and not on any other oral or written statement with respect to the offering of shares in the Fund, Smith & Williamson, the Investment Adviser, any placing agent or any partner, officer, director, employee, shareholder or affiliate of any of them, and he was not offered the opportunity to invest in the Fund by means of any form of general solicitation or advertising, such as media advertising, public seminars or publicly accessible website;
- (i) he agrees not to offer, sell, transfer, pledge, hypothecate or otherwise dispose of, directly or indirectly, all or any part of the shares in the Fund or any interest therein, except in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Prospectus and applicable law (including, without limitation, the registration requirements of the Securities Act of 1933 or an exemption therefrom, and any other applicable securities laws). In addition, the Applicant further agrees that he is not currently making (and at the time of the purchase of the shares in the Fund will not be making) a market in the shares in the Fund (or on any part of any parallel funds and will not, at any time after he purchases shares in the Fund, make a market in any such shares;
- (j) he represents and warrants that he is a U.S. citizen or resident individual and he has delivered to the Fund a complete, valid original executed Internal Revenue Service Form W-9 and will deliver to the Fund an updated complete, valid original executed form (or any successor or other form prescribed by the Internal Revenue Service) on or before the date that the form expires, or becomes obsolete or incorrect;
- (k) he acknowledges that the Fund, Smith & Williamson and their legal counsel are relying on the declarations, warranties and representations made by the Applicant in this Application and that the foregoing are true, correct and complete as of the date of this Application and should there be any change in such information, he will immediately furnish in writing such revised or corrected information to Smith & Williamson;
- (l) he is an "accredited investor", as defined in rule 501(a) of Regulation D under the US Securities Act and represents and warrants that each of the statements below, next to which he has indicated in the space designated therefore, is true
 - (i) he is a natural person whose individual net worth, or joint net worth with his spouse at the time of his making an investment in the Fund, exceeds \$1,000,000; or
 - (ii) he is a natural person who had an individual income in excess of \$200,000 in each of the two most recent years or joint income with his spouse in excess of \$300,000 in each of those years and has a reasonable expectation of reaching the same income level in the current year;
- (m) he first learned of the Fund in the State listed in his address above, and intends that the securities law of that State govern the making of his subscription;
- (n) he is a "qualified purchaser" within the meaning of Section 2(a)(51) of the US Investment Company Act because he is a natural person who owns not less than \$5 million in "investments" (for this purpose, the term "investments" has the meaning set forth in Rule 2a51-1, and the amount of his "investments" has been determined in the manner required by such Rule); and
- (o) if at any time while he holds shares in the Fund he is no longer in compliance with the declarations, representations and warranties contained in this Schedule, he shall promptly notify Smith & Williamson.
